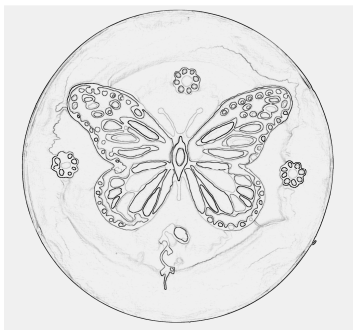

Please arrange for **two** letters of recommendations to be submitted on your behalf following these guidelines:

- While there is no preferred format, a letter of recommendation should explain how the applicant meets the scholarship criteria. Include an address and phone number, so that information may be clarified or verified.
- One of the letters must be from a Tallmadge High School staff member: a teacher, administrator, or activity sponsor.
- Another letter may be from someone whose life has been positively affected by the applicant, e.g.: a community or activity sponsor, employer, minister, teacher, peer, etc.
- Each letter must be submitted directly by the letter writer. However, it is the applicant's responsibility both to provide the letter writer with all relevant information and to remind the letter writer to submit the letter on time.

The contents of letters of recommendation will be kept as confidential as current and future laws regarding confidentiality allow.
